3. Financial Report:	SCBC's Financial Manger Lonnie Prouse on behalf of Secretary/Treasurer, provided the annual Financial Report: SCBC experienced a financially successful year. We raised money from all levels of government and saw an increase in foundation funding. We continued to work with the Habitat Stewardship Program on multi-year commitments and secured multi-year funding with the Real Estate Foundation and the Sitka Foundation. All of our expenses were within budget and under contract within specific SCBC projects. A highlight that our profit and loss statement does not include is the contribution of our in-kind support: 34% of our total cash and in-kind budget consists of in-kind contributions, which makes it the largest contribution to SCBC.
