




## Keep Cats Indoors or Supervised Outdoors to Make B.C. A Safer Place For Cats And Birds

After habitat loss, roaming cats are the #1 source of wild bird mortality.

In Canada, cats kill between 100 and 350 million birds per year.

## **Dangers Cats Face Outside:**

- unwanted pregnancy
- trauma from cat fights
- injury or death from wildlife
- getting lost
- trauma and death from vehicles
- diseases and parasites passed on from wildlife (salmonella, rabies)
- ingesting toxins



## WHAT YOU CAN DO!

- Keep your cat indoors
- If allowed outdoors, ensure supervision:
  - Leash walking
  - Outdoor enclosure
  - Birdbesafe™ cat collar
  - Limit time outside
- ✓ Neuter/Spay
- Cat license, permanent ID
- Support local birds!
